Request for Waiver

Divorced, separated or never married parents retain the obligation to contribute to the education of their children. The Cincinnati Waldorf School is not bound by any agreement specifying a parent's responsibility for educational expenses. Both natural parents must provide the financial information requested each year. Under extraordinary circumstances, the Cincinnati Waldorf School may choose to waive this requirement. A parent may request a waiver of the requirement that the non-custodial parent submit information by signing and submitting this form or by submitting the alternative request for waiver as outlined below.

Alternate Request for Waiver

The Cincinnati Waldorf School recognizes that there may be family situations where there may be some contact from the non-custodial parent but the non-custodial parent is incapable, for medical or other reasons, of providing support. The custodial parent in these circumstances should submit both a written statement of the family circumstances plus the Required Written Statement as outlined below.

Required Written Statement:

In addition, the Cincinnati Waldorf School requires a written statement from a non-family member who understands your family situation in a professional capacity. For example, you may request a doctor, lawyer, member of the clergy, or a social worker submit a statement on your behalf.
